Dostoevsky is a balkanized world with a number of nations that are Imperial client states.

Planetary Law Level averages 3. There are notable exceptions. Konra's citizens are prohibited from owning weapons of any kind, but visiting starship crew are allowed to register and possess weapons up to Law Level 3. The citizens of Aasun enjoy more freedom and are able to possess weapons at Law Level 2.

The worldwide Tech Level averages TL-10, with exceptions for Aasun, Konra and Torshavn that have moderate amounts of Tech Level 12 capability.

Political:

The nation Konra is ruled by an uncharismatic dictator, Premier Ko. A relatively successful rebel movement has taken over a number of towns near Konra's border with the nation Aasun. Premier Ko is to be succeeded by his second, Assistant Premier Khun.

Premier Ko has ruled Konra for three decades and is very unpopular due to his policy of excessive military spending at the expense of the country's infrastructure and the standard of living. Several parts of Konra have populations living on the edge of starvation. Due to the increased unpopularity of Premier Ko, rebel activity in Konra is on the rise.

Military:

Most nations have army and navy units equipped to Tech Level 10. Aasun and Konra military units are typically Tech Level 12. Their elite units tend to be equipped with Tech Level 13 equipment that is imported from off world.

Konra maintains a paramilitary police force, the GOK, which is used for control of the population as well as counterinsurgency operations. The GOK is composed of picked troops, equipped to Tech Level 13 and is well trained.
